

SAA BOAT HANDLING INSTRUCTOR

OBJECTIVES

To provide highly skilled instructors who will have a wide range of boating and navigation skills, so as to be able to organise and run any or all of the SAA Boat Handling Courses.

The criteria for anyone who holds a Power Boat Instructors certificate issued by another governing body and wishes to become an SAA Boat Handling Instructor is :-

REQUIREMENTS

- 1 Current SAA membership.
- 2 SAA Diver Coxswain certificate.
- 3 Hold a valid First Aid certificate or Oxygen Administration certificate.
- 4 Assisted on an SAA Boat Handling course.

QUALIFICATION AWARDED

Boat Handling Instructor certificate.

SENIOR OR EXAMINING INSTRUCTOR

REQUIREMENTS

- 1 Current SAA membership.
- 2 Hold a Regional Instructor certificate or an equivalent qualification from another organisation.
- 3 Held a Basic Boat Handling certificate for two years.
- 4 Instructed on at least two Diver Cox'n courses.
- 5 Hold a valid First Aid certificate or Oxygen Administration certificate
- 6 Passed a written examination.
- 7 Passed a practical test of Basic Boat Handling.

QUALIFICATION AWARDED

Senior Boat Handling Instructor certificate.
